

Possible Walking School Bus Routes for West Woodland

Walking school buses provide a safe and fun way to get to school on foot. Link up with your neighbors to agree on walking days and take turns leading your bus.

Use one of these routes or start a new route.

Set your walk schedule to arrive for the beginning of the school day or in time for before-school activities, depending on your group's needs.

Volunteer to be the contact person or leader for your route on International Walk to School Day!

Here are some walking school buses that can catch lots of WW kids:

- Start at Ross Park, walk north on 3rd Ave NW.
- Start at 46th & 6th Ave NW, walk north on 6th Av NW.
- Start at NW 70th & 3rd Ave NW; walk south on 3rd Ave NW, cross NW 65th St, then south on 4th Ave NW.
- Start at 60th & Sycamore, walk on 60th (down the p-patch), south on 3rd NW to the cross walk at 58th, then west on 58th to school. (This has been going daily since Sept. '06)
- Start at “zoo park” (59th & Phinney), walk west under Phinney Ave, then down the hill to 56th & 3rd.
- Start at N 50th & Woodland Park N, by the tennis courts, walk west on 50th, north on Phinney to meet with the park group at 59th.
- Start at 9th Ave NW & NW 63rd at 8:45; walk south on 9th Ave NW, then east on 58th.
- Start at Gilman Playfield (NW 54th St & 9th Av NW), walk east on NW 54th, north on 8th Av NW, east on Market, cross at Dominos.
